COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Entries will be accepted between **8.30am and 10.45am** in the Craft Pavilion.
2. Please register your entry with the Steward of the relevant section .
3. The Society will not accept responsibility for any loss of, or damage to exhibits. during the show, or in transit to or from the showground
4. Exhibits must remain on display until **4pm**.
5. Exhibits may be collected between **4pm and 5pm**. Exhibits left in the Craft Pavilion after 5pm will be the responsibility of the exhibitor.
6. Judging will take place between **11am and 1pm**. Only Judges and Stewards will be allowed in the competitions area of the Pavilion during judging.
7. All cookery exhibits must be displayed on a suitable plate or dish, and covered. (Cling film will be available from the Stewards)
8. Cups and trophies will be presented at **1.30pm** in the Craft Pavilion.
9. Prize money will be paid out between **2pm and 5pm** in the Craft Pavilion.
10. In the event of a tie, for a trophy for the most points, the winner will be the competitor with the most first prizes, or will be decided by the Stewards.
11. All classes are "open" unless specified.
12. Entry to any competition assumes that the competitor gives the Society permission to show the competitor's name on any prize cards and to contact the competitor in the future on any matter relating to the show.

1. Judge's Recipe – Beirniad / Judge: Llinos Jones

The “**Halfway**” **Perpetual Trophy** and a **cash prize of £20**, donated by **Towy Valley Caravan Park**, will be awarded to the winner of the judge's recipe.

ALMOND SLICE

BASE:	1½ oz caster sugar	3oz butter	4½ oz plain flour
TOPPING	100g black cherry jam	3 eggs	
	6oz margarine	1½ tsp baking powder	
	6oz caster sugar	1½ tsp almond extract	
	6oz self-raising flour	flaked almonds	

Turn oven to 170° fan. Line 10” x 8” (or similar) tin with baking paper.

BASE: Rub the butter and flour for the base together until it resembles fine breadcrumbs. Mix in the sugar. Put the mixture into the tin, even it out and press firmly. Place tin in the oven and cook for 10 minutes. Leave to cool then layer the jam over the base.

TOPPING: Mix the margarine and sugar together until light and fluffy. Mix the eggs and add gradually to the mixture, beating constantly. Fold the flour, baking powder and almond extract into the mix until it forms a sponge-like consistency. Spread the sponge mix over the jam, then sprinkle with flaked almonds. Cook for 30 – 40 minutes until golden and the sponge bounces to touch. Remove from the oven and sprinkle with caster sugar.

Leave to cool before removing from the tin and cut into squares or fingers.
